



Williams has garnered many awards including two NAACP Image Awards, two Emmy nominations and an ACTRA Award of Excellence. Presently Williams is one of the Executive Producers of *The Jane Austen Marriage Manual*, a feature that is currently in development with Don Carmody Productions. As passionate as she is about ReelWorld and producing, she continues her first love 'acting', most recently in the film *LAPD African Cop* due for release summer 2014.

Canada's Most Diverse Community Meets Canada's Most Diverse Film Festival

Emerging artists, filmmakers, and film aficionados in Markham are marking April 11 to 13 in their calendars, ready to experience a ReelWorld Film Festival extravaganza, including the screening of more than 30 films and videos, workshops for youth and an industry panel for York Region artists. Our programmers even slated four films by York Region-based artists, two family friendly screenings and worked with the Mayor's Youth Council to plan a music video night celebration.

ReelWorld's expansion to the City of Markham began as a spark of a conversation in early 2013, at the launch of Diversity Magazine, one of ReelWorld's partners. Mayor Frank Scarpitti invited ReelWorld to Markham, and we announced our expansion to Canada's most diverse community at the opening of the 2013 ReelWorld Film Festival.

Mayor Scarpitti, Commissioner of Community and Fire Services Brenda Librecz, and Director of Culture Mohammed Hosseini-Ara invited Markham community leaders to create a steering committee to help develop a stellar three-day event in Markham. This group has given our programming team insights about content of interest to Markham residents, they have introduced the ReelWorld team to potential partners and they have been helping us get the word out about our screening and events taking place at Cornell Community Centre & Public Library (3201 Bur Oak Avenue Markham) and Cineplex Odeon First Markham Place Cinemas (3275 Hwy 7 E., Markham).

Meryem is a beautiful, peaceful village with a hidden darkness. The village is presented seductively through Feza Caldıran's cinematography, but our protagonist is struggling within the confines of a child marriage. Rather than resorting to a simple demonstration of an overbearing husband or a confined house, director Atalay Taşdiken has taken a more elegant approach. He skilfully evokes a sense of claustrophobia, even within the idyllic setting and with the husband distantly removed.

A tragedy shakes the lives of an aimless group of Asian Canadian twenty-somethings, spurring them to embark on an ambitious journey to become millionaires before they turn 30. But, chasing the almighty dollar never comes without its costs. Their first business venture proves more dangerous than they could have imagined.

PROGRAMMER'S NOTE

The Toronto-based webseries-turned-feature-film *Millions* is definitely a project made with plenty of ambition and passion. Andrew Chung has brought together a talented ensemble cast of actors, led by Hubert Chan, in an intriguing drama about expectations and ambition. Another enjoyment of *Millions* is that it does not play to the stereotypical Asian characters.

Moose River Crossing is based on the play that examines the premise and asks the question, "Does time heal all wounds?". Six past residential school students meet at a train station on their way to a reunion. Having survived the experience of what many consider one of Canada's darkest periods, each still carries physical and emotional scars. As they wait, each goes on a journey of remembrance, ultimately leading them to seek inner resolution.

PROGRAMMER'S NOTE

Stark, depressing, claustrophobic. Veteran filmmaker Shirley Cheechoo shows considerable complexity mining rich emotions in this simple (but effective) film about a reunion gone bad. Rivalries continue, old loves return, new bonds form. The Aboriginal experience is cleverly revealed in this original play adaptation that never feels stagnant or stagy. The cinematography is also effective - alternating between blackand-white and colour to great effect. Mockumentary-style interviews recur throughout in this hard-to-watch drama.



Andrew C is a Toronto-based writer and director with a screenwriting diploma from the Vancouver Film School. His films, Word and Beauty Heart Story, toured festivals and received distribution. ReelSpeak delves into the life of actor, director and producer Oscar **Torre** in front of a live audience. CTV Anchor and Reporter Andria Case will ask Torre about his career, and how he balances his personal time with a growing, vibrant career on screen. We also find out what drove him to step behind the lens with his directorial debut of the award-winning film **Pretty Rosebud**.

Oscar Torre's breakout role came when he was cast as Cuban refugee Santo on the 2007 CBS show Cane, a role for which he won a 2008 Fuego Award. Since Cane, the Miami-born actor has guest starred on numerous programs including FOX TV's hit series Dollhouse and CBS's top-rated shows NCIS, Cold Case, and The Mentalist. He received critical acclaim for his work in the film Ladrón que roba a ladrón, which at the time had the highest grossing weekend ever for a Spanish-language film.

Torre was also lauded for his performance as a Cuban political prisoner in the film Libertad: The Dark Untold Story of Castro's Cuba. In addition to roles in HBO's Larceny, Counterpunch, and Hunting of Man, Torre played a supporting role in the 2013 blockbuster film The Hangover Part III opposite Bradley Cooper, Zack Galifianakis, and Ed Helms.

In 2014, Torre made his directorial debut with Pretty Rosebud, a film that he also produced after he read and was "captured" by a script brilliantly written by actress and first-time screenwriter Chuti-Tiu. He felt compelled to tell the story with respect.



OSCAR TORRE, DIRECTOR

Without a formal education in film production but with countless hours on set. Torre took on the challenge of telling the story of flawed and believable characters. The endeavour garnered Torre his first "Best Director" award, in addition to four additional awards from the Idyllwild International Film Festival (IIFC): Best Feature Film, Best Screenplay, Best Actress (Chuti Tiu) and Best Cinematography (Tarina Reed), a first in IIFC's history.

Pretty Rosebud is a passion project for Torre. It tells the story of career-driven Cissy, who everyone believes has an ideal life. But striving to be the perfect wife and daughter has pushed Cissy to her breaking point. Her childless marriage to an unemployed architect has grown stale, and the cultural and religious pressures of her traditional parents propel her to defy societal taboos, awakening something so primal it is both shocking and revelatory.

Ana Serrano: 2014 ReelWorld Visionary Award Recipient

The ReelWorld Visionary Award recognizes individuals who continue to make a significant contribution to the Canadian entertainment industry by opening doors for others and changing the Canadian entertainment landscape. Some past recipients of this award include Claire Prieto, Cameron Bailey, Fil Fraser and Helen Paul.



Three endings, more than 3 billion story possibilities, and 380 available remote control clicks: Welcome to participatory cinema, where an audience of one or many can change how a narrative unfolds. Introducing one of digital media's foremost pioneers: Ana Serrano, this year's 2014 Visionary Award Recipient.

In a world where you can watch on your phone, TV and game consoles, Serrano is dreaming up what we will be watching next while creating new blueprints for ever increasing ways to enjoy it. A champion of user-driven storytelling, her work masterfully fuses the technical know-how of role playing video games with the classic art of character-driven cinema.

Serrano is fearless about working with new technologies, emerging artists and embracing gritty storylines to captivate audiences. Having directed the development of more than 100 different interactive media projects, and as producer, executive producer and interactive architect for *Late Fragment*, North America's first interactive drama, she accomplished all of the above. The co-production between the National Film Board of Canada and the Canadian Film Centre's (CFC) Media Lab, *Late Fragment* is an initiative that created at least 13 different digital technologies.

Her latest works *Prison Dancer* and *Body/Mind/Change* continue the innovation. The first, a personal project, captures the lives of six convicts in the Philippines - three straight, two, gay and one transgendered- whose stories are told through dance and song. It's a transmedia project, which has been launched on the Web and on stage in New York, winning accolades and awards for both platforms. The second, a co-production between TIFF and CFC Media Lab, is the first interactive narrative experience to generate a physical object — a 3D-printed organism called POD — and stars David Cronenberg.

Named one of *Maclean's* magazine's "100 Canadians to Watch," Serrano is the winner of three 2003 Canadian New Media Awards and was selected the sole Canadian expert panel member for the 2003, 2005 and 2007 World Summit Awards, part of the United Nations' World Summit on the Information Society. In 2000, she produced the *Great Canadian Story Engine Project*, a national tour and bilingual website that created an interactive storytelling community for Canadians. In 1997, she created the lab that eventually became the CFC New Media Lab. Now, she is the first ever Chief Digital Officer of the Canadian Film Centre, tasked with bringing the CFC's programs, operations, infrastructure, and partnerships into the digital age.

Roy T. Anderson is the writer, director and producer of the award-winning film, Akwantu: The Journey, about the history of the Jamaican Maroons. A veteran movie stuntman, Anderson has accumulated more than 400 production credits while working on hits like The Dark Knight Rises, Bourne Ultimatum, and Wolf of Wall Street.

DO YOU FEEL THE CANADIAN ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY IS HEADING IN A POSITIVE DIRECTION?

The film industry definitely has become more inclusive. There is, however, still a long way to go, and it will take perseverance and vigilance by others to effectively address this under-representation. I am proud, however, to have gotten my start in Toronto. I was well prepared for the world stage.




INS CHOI

WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE AN EMERGING ARTIST?

You will constantly be rejected. You will continually fail. You will often feel alone and convince yourself it's not worth it. This is not really advice, but what to expect. Oh, and only a small number of artists who are determined to continue are ever celebrated.



WAAWAATE FOBISTER

A proud Anishnaabe from Grassy Narrows First Nation, **Waawaate Fobister** is an award-winning actor and playwright. In 2009, his production of *Agokwe* won six Dora Awards and he was nominated for Edmonton's Sterling Award for Best Actor. In 2013, Fobister helped produce, curate and write for *Wrecking Ball 14 – Idle No More*.

HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE THE WORK THAT YOU DO TO INSPIRE PEOPLE?

As a theatre artist I call myself an Anishnaabe storyteller. My people were always storytellers, that's how our traditions, beliefs, and practices were passed down generation by generation. The job of the artist is to inspire, shift views and make people question. I try to create work that does that within the Anishnaabe worldview.

Born and raised in Toronto, **Sangita Patel** joined ET Canada in 2013 as an Entertainment Reporter. After graduating university as a professional engineer, she volunteered with Rogers Community Television and eventually reported for the local lifestyle show, *Toronto Living*; and *Rushes*, the highlight show for the Toronto International Film Festival.

DO YOU FEEL THE CANADIAN ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY IS HEADING IN A POSITIVE DIRECTION?

Canada is brimming with incredible talent in all aspects of the entertainment industry. As an entertainment reporter, it's wonderful to see such work first-hand, and to report on all the amazing accolades our Canadians get within these borders and beyond. I am proud to be Canadian!



KIM ROBERTS

KIM ROBERTS' acting career spans 20 years and boasts more than 200 credits. A multi-faceted artist, Roberts is also a co-founder of the Obsidian Theatre Company. She has appeared in FX's The Strain, Global TV's Remedy, Lucky 7, Being Erica, Dawn of the Dead, Rookie Blue, Blue Bloods, Suits, Lost Girl, and Degrassi: The Next Generation.

WHAT ADVICE WOULD YOU GIVE AN EMERGING ARTIST?

Do what you love the most. As creative individuals, we are often multi-talented. Sometimes it can be hard to know what to focus on. But you must focus, in the beginning at least. Put your 100-percent in the direction you love the most, in the thing you would do for free.




FILEN WONG


HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE THE WORK THAT YOU DO TO INSPIRE PEOPLE?
