Reelworld Screen Institute, a non-profit, provides training programs and presents the acclaimed Reelworld Film Festival, which celebrates stories by racialized Canadians. Providing access to opportunities is core to Reelworld, and Access Reelworld is Canada's leading hiring platform for racialized crews and talent. Reelworld Foundation, a registered charity, is transforming the industry by creating mechanisms that hold systems accountable for greater equity.

The Reelworld Producer Program is a year-long program that provides learning opportunities and creates pathways to build a career as a producer in the television industry. The program candidates will be immersed in the business side of the Canadian entertainment field. After selecting a project, they will learn valuable skills such as creating a corporation, retaining intellectual property rights, choosing and optioning scripts, creating deal memos, choosing key creatives and casting directors, plus much more.



23rd Annual Reelworld Film Festival at the Paradise Theatre

Reelworld is Canada's longest-running film festival and institute committed to advancing opportunities for Black, Indigenous, Asian, South Asian, and People of Colour in the Canadian screen industries. Our goal is to reduce barriers and foster authentic stories. The film festival showcases a lineup of feature films and various short films from four different short programs, with themes that change yearly. All the films in the festival are created by Canadian Black, Indigenous, Asian, and People of Colour.

Reelworld Film Festival proudly presents cash and in-kind awards valued over \$45,000. This year, they awarded \$25,000 for Outstanding Feature Film and \$10,000 for Outstanding Short Film.
